Field report on the Training of Trainers' Workshop held in Mbale

As the Civic Education partners are preparing to continue rolling out civic education in their respective communities having received their CE IEC materials that the RC delivered to them, it was planned that a training of trainers' workshop be organized to help guide the conduct of civic education.

To implement this, partner CSOs were asked to send 2 members from their organizations who are directly involved in the conduct/managing of civic education to undergo a special training of trainers' workshop. After this training, which took place at Viola Hotel, they are expected to go back and train their community facilitators who will ably and correctly deliver civic education in their communities.

Eleven (11) partner CSOs responded to this call and sent 2 participants each (though others requested to allow 3 of their staff to participate) to participate in the training. The training was facilitated by the facilitators indicated on the attached program of the day.

The following UPIMAC RC staff participated: **1** RCC, **1** PO, **2** Volunteers for purposes of giving them exposure and gaining experience.

In total 28 participants attended.

Challenges

1. Coordinating participants was a challenge as some of them could not be contacted due to network problems. This made it difficult to effectively plan for them.
2. Participants from CCG did not come because the ED of CCG had lost a brother yet CCG was supposed to chair a session.
